- An official IELTS score (within 1-year validity) is also accepted.
- Band Score below 3.5: Advised to take IELTS Intro until they reach a band score of 4.0.

Requirements for Guarantee

Students must:

- Maintain 95%+ attendance (including twilight classes).

▶ FAMILY PROGRAM

We welcome parent-child pairs who wish to experience English language learning together. To maintain the integrity and effectiveness of our Family Program, please take note of the following policies:

1. Parent Participation Requirement

Parents must enroll in a study program alongside their child. Merely paying for dormitory accommodation and accompanying the child without joining classes is not allowed. Parents may choose any program they wish to join.

2. Curriculum and Materials

To ensure consistency and fairness in our academic approach, parents are not allowed to request changes to their child's curriculum or learning materials—this includes requesting a higher-level book directly from the teacher. If a level adjustment is needed, the student must undergo a re-evaluation, which can be requested at the Admin Office.

WALES organizes a school trip every two weeks as part of our cultural and social enrichment activities. These events are open to all students and provide a great opportunity to explore local culture while using English in real-life settings. If a parent or family member would like to join, advance registration is required at the admin office. Please note that additional fees may apply, and participation is subject to availability.

4. Unruly Junior's Behavior

If a student disobeys their teachers and continues to display unruly behavior even after counseling with the parents, the management has the authority to cancel the class.
